



# Central Orange County Food Swap Disclaimer and Release of Liability

While swaps are community events, participants must pre-register, which means swap events are operated as private clubs. In addition, all swap participants adhere to an honor code of using the highest cleanliness standards in their own kitchens and gardens to prepare their swap items.

Swappers must agree to the following terms before participating in the Central Orange County Food Swap:

- By participating in these events, you are acknowledging that the food items being traded are not necessarily prepared in commercial kitchens or spaces inspected by any government agency
- By participating in these events, you are also acknowledging that you will use the highest standards of safety and cleanliness in food preparation.
